What it does is match the amount that your military retirement is reduced due to the drawing of a disability allowance. Plus they match it tax free, so it's like doubling you disability payment. If you are interested in checking this out go to <http://askafpc.randolph.af.mil> then click on retiree services, then under "Useful Links" click on "Combat Related Compensation". Check it out; it will be worth your While. For those of you who don't have Internet, there's a toll free number 1-800-616-3775 then select 1,1,2.
